SRA manages the wastes of ship scraps dismantled in Aliğa Ship Dismantling Region and publishes the Waste Management Procedure through the website www.gemisander.com to the relevant parties

SRA provides assistance to the recycling companies in the region for ambulance, first aid service and marine pollution incidents.

Organizes and measures training to the recycling companies employees about the environmental awareness and the management methods of waste caused by the scrap vessels,

SRA has documented and applies its Management System which was built on the restrictions of 14001/2015-ISO 45001/2018 standards. Performs performance evaluations of external service providers within the scope of defined criteria which may affect the performance of the Environment and OHSAS.
